## Youth Sailing Scheme Stage 2

- Can put a dinghy head to wind and rig it.
- Understands how to manoeuvre a trolley and boat clear of other boats and overhead cables.
- Can launch and recover a dinghy in an offshore wind.
- Can tie a round turn and two half hitches.
- Can control speed and stop by lying to.
- Can go about (close reach to close reach) and get out of irons.
- Can crew a dinghy effectively without instruction\* (i.e. adjust foresail, daggerboard and body weight).
- Can sail a shallow triangle across the wind under supervision (gybing optional).
- Understands the five essentials.
- Can be scooped in during capsize recovery.
- OR Can right a single-handed dinghy.
- Understands the No Go Zone.
- Understands what is meant by windward, leeward and gybe.
- Has knowledge of
  - Parts of the sail
  - Spars and rigging
  - Sail controls and foils
  - Offshore and onshore winds
  - Telling someone ashore
- Understands the dangers of overhead power lines, locks and weirs.
- Understands several ways of finding wind direction.
